We're seeking young singers (K-12) to sing *The Promise Song* for the 50th Anniversary of Earth Day as a virtual choir member. It's as simple as A, B, C!

- A. Learn The Promise Song: We have e-mailed you the recording and the sheet music. Download both onto your computer. Listen to The Promise Song a couple of times and follow along with the words, then start singing. Pretty soon you'll be singing it in your sleep!
- B. Use a phone to video record yourself singing *The Promise Song* (See helpful hints in the right column)
- C. Send the recording to the studio by Monday, April 13th, along with a video release form

How To Make A Good Recording (Courtesy of School Shine)

- 1. Stand near a bright window light
- 2. Place your phone on a surface rather than holding it in your hand
- 3. Video record with the phone in a horizontal position
- Make sure your phone quality is 1080 or higher (check in phone settings under "camera")
- 5. Use an earbud (preferably) or headphones so you can hear *The Promise Song* as you sing along.
- As you make your video recording you will hear a countdown and clapping. Please clap 8 times with the recording. Look at the camera and smile and wait for the music to begin. Then video record yourself singing *The Promise Song.* When the song is done, please smile and look at the camera and wait for 10 seconds.
- 7. Did we say SMILE? Please smile both before, during, and after your recording

*The words to *The Promise Song* were written by Tessa and William Hill to honor their son, Clint, who had formed a group called Kids for Saving Earth before he died at age 11. The words were set to music by Ronnie Brooks and produced by Hummingbird Productions ©1990. Kids for Saving Earth became an international organization and *The Promise Song* was performed on Broadway (by Raffi) and at the United Nations.
